JoeAnna's House has always been about more than a place to stay. It is about comfort, belonging and the quiet reassurance that, even in the hardest moments, no family has to face them alone.

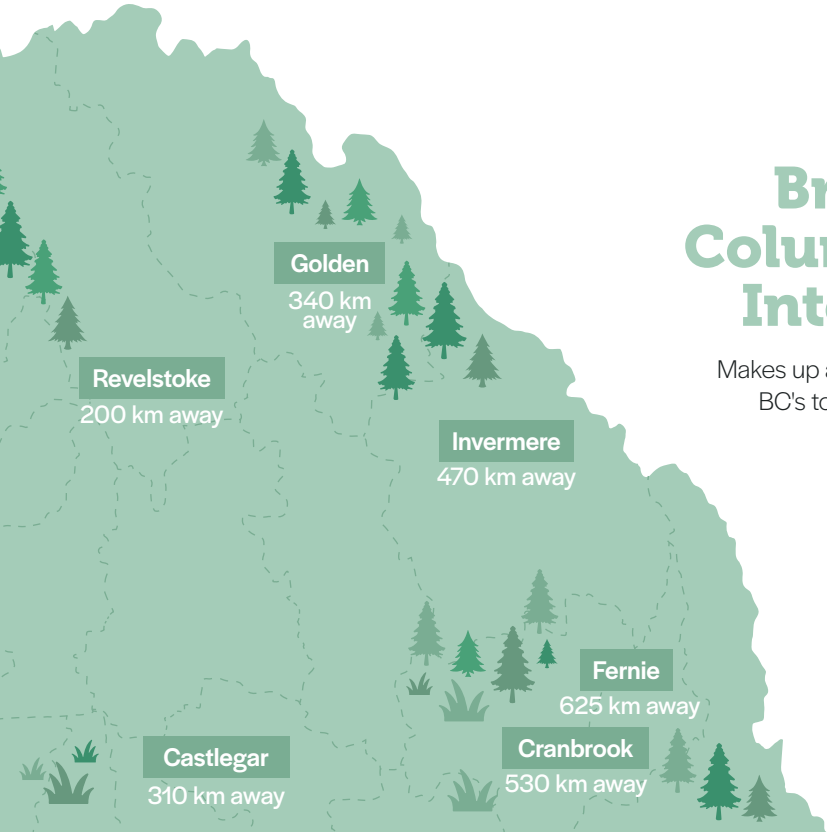
Thank you for helping us open our doors to those with the weight of the world on their shoulders, so together we can give them the gift of being close when it matters most.

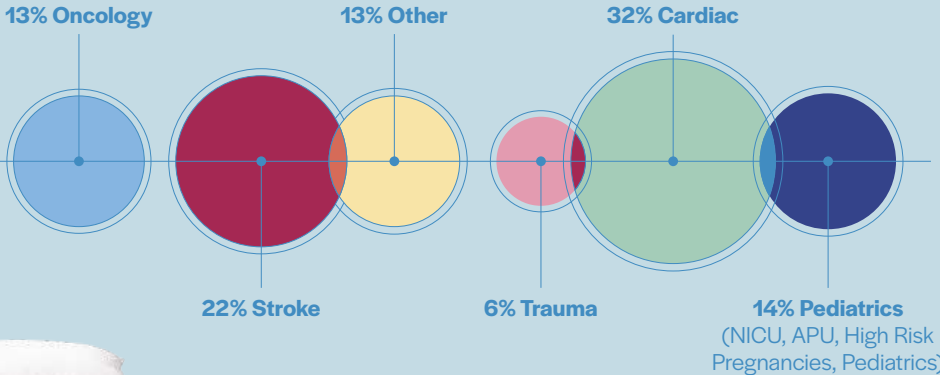

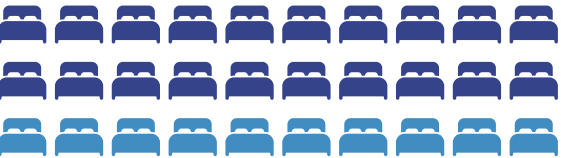
